



One-day trip: hike Chinchero and Pisac

STARTS AND ENDS: Cusco

Pretty, charming scenery, two spectacular ruins, and plenty of easy walking. A lovely, gentle day in the outdoors that also includes two significant Inca sites and the most famous market in the region.

We'll pick you up from your Cusco accommodation at 9am and drive about an hour to Chinchero, known for its charming church and Inca stronghold perched on a hillside. From here we'll start hiking a track that descends gently through a winding valley, and out through Urquillos, a paradise-like mountain hideaway, into the Sacred Valley.

From here we'll ride in our private vehicle to Pisac, just a few minutes down the road, and explore this charming little town's cobbled streets, carved stone buildings, and hidden courtyards – not to mention Pisac's famous craft market. It's the largest in the region and a perfect opportunity for souvenir or gift shopping! Then your guide will show you around the Inca fortress that towers over the town – a massive and intricate series of bristling fortifications and protective terracing – before heading back to Cusco.
